

The US Cooperative for International Patient Programs (USCIPP) is accepting nominations for the 2019 International Humanitarian and Global Health Leadership Award. This award recognizes an individual (or team of individuals) who:

- Demonstrates leadership in international humanitarian and/or global health initiatives that may not necessarily fall within international patient services;
- Has made an exceptional contribution to global health or international humanitarian initiatives; and
- Supports international humanitarian and/or global health efforts that align with USCIPP's mission of expanding global access to US expertise in high-quality healthcare

Nominees should be associated with a USCIPP member organization or its parent institution, but they do not necessarily need to be directly employed by the hospital or medical center. Nominees for the award must be actively engaged in and use their influence to positively shape their field. Self-nominations are not eligible.

The recipient(s) of the 2019 International Humanitarian and Global Health Leadership Award will be honored during the 2019 USCIPP Leadership Award Dinner on the evening of **Thursday, June 13, 2019**, in conjunction with the USCIPP annual meeting in Houston.

3. Promotes and raises awareness of issues related to improving health and achieving health equality
4. Demonstrates innovation by opening channels, sharing best practices, strengthening systems, and/or advancing technologies to promote the improvement of the health status of a population
